

## Skye Canyon Park Field Use Rules and Regulations

1. The Skye Canyon Community Association will be responsible for scheduling and permitting all field and park reservations. The Skye Canyon Community Association cannot guarantee the same field(s) each year based on user group requests or growth from year to year. Submission of a field use request does not constitute approval. Approval is given in writing according to the applicable policy, field availability, when all requirements have been met, and fees have been paid. The Skye Canyon Community Association has exclusive discretion in decisions related to the scheduling of community fields.
2. All users' schedules are REQUIRED at least one (1) week prior to the start of the season to ensure that proper light schedules and field maintenance schedules may be implemented.
3. Users may not sub-lease their assigned fields and/or times to any other league or individual. Any date(s) not utilized by the permitted league(s) will revert to the Skye Canyon Community Association for their use or reassignment. Refunds for unused dates will not be provided.
4. Field users shall be responsible for all set-up and breakdown of goals, cones, equipment, etc. All leagues shall keep the grounds, fields, and areas in a clean condition free of litter and shall ensure that there is no damage to landscaping, surrounding sidewalks, hardscapes or structures. This requirement shall be maintained on game days as well as practice times. Failure to clean will result in a cleaning fee and future use may be immediately revoked.
5. All groups/organizations reserving a Skye Canyon field are required to have a \$1,000,000 general liability certificate of insurance naming Skye Canyon Community Association, Olympia Management Services, LLC, their Parent, Subsidiaries, Affiliated Companies and their respective Owners, Directors, Officers, Members and Employees are named as additionally insured (ATIMA) and they shall be shown as additional insureds on all Certificates of Insurance except Workers Compensation and Professional Liability. All insurance is Primary and Non-Contributory. Waivers of Subrogation and CG 2010 endorsements apply.
6. No alcohol may be consumed or served on the premises.
7. The Skye Canyon Community Association Board of Directors reserves the right to revoke facility use privileges of any group/individual who does not comply with the Rules and Regulations or who abuses or damages the property.
8. Groups are encouraged to bring their Field Reservation Permit (provided by the Skye Canyon Community Association) with them on their reserved date(s). In the event of a conflict, the group holding a confirmed Field Reservation Permit receives field priority.
9. Use of Skye Canyon fields is allocated only for the dates indicated on the Field Reservation Permit. Prior use of a Skye Canyon field does not ensure use in future field reservation cycles.
